Australia Awards Scholarships is offered for Postgraduate level (Masters or Doctorate) degree at Australian Institutions Eligibility:	Australia Awards Pacific Scholarships is offered for undergraduate and postgraduate level at the University of the South Pacific (USP) in Fiji, Samoa, Vanuatu, Fiji National University (FNU) and University of Papua New Guinea (UPNG)
 For Master's degree, applicant must have a Bachelor's degree with a minimum of 3 years work experience in the field you wish to study Must not hold or have held a scholarship to study outside their home country in the 24 months preceding the application Applicants should have an IELTS or TOEFL at pass rate of 6.5 for each band that is current at the time of application Scores must be valid at 1 January 2021. Must not hold a Master's Degree at either time For Doctorate degree, applicant must have Master's degree and minimum of 3 years work experience in the field you wish to study. Must hold a Master's Degree and have achieved above average results and have at least 3 years' relevant work experience Must not hold or have held a scholarship to study outside their home country in the 24 months preceding the application Applicants must have achieved an IELTS (Academic) score of 6.5 or higher (with no individual band score of less than 6.0) or an equivalent TOEFL or PTE score. Scores must be 	 Eligibility: For undergraduate study program at USP & UPNG, applicants must have an Associate's degree with a minimum of 3.0 GPA For postgraduate study program at USP & UPNG, applicants must have a bachelor's degree with at least 3 years' work experience For MBBS study program at FNU, applicants must have an Associate's degree with a minimum of 3.5 - 4.0 GPA including a pass in English AND Biology, plus 2 other science subjects: Chemistry OR HCOP Courses For other undergraduate medical study programs at FNU, applicants must have an Associate's degree with a minimum 3.0 - 3.5 GPA including a pass in English AND Biology, plus 2 other science subjects: OR HCOP Courses For postgraduate study program at FNU, applicants must have a bachelor's degree with at least 3 years' work experience
